Support Academic Development

- Ensure regular school attendance and punctuality.
- Monitor homework, study habits, and progress.
- Encourage reading, curiosity, and learning at home.

Uphold Islamic Values

- Promote honesty, humility, and respect toward elders and teachers.

Respect School Policies

- Raise concerns constructively through appropriate channels.
